3. Officers Reports
  - a. President's Report
    - \* The PTO started out the new school year by giving each teacher a \$100 for out of pocket expenses.
    - \* PTO has been notified of a change in the Kroger Incentive Program for the year. They will no longer be linking the donation to customer cards; instead they will be holding a contest with the maximum award of \$2500 for only one winner. This will be a loss of income for the PTO. Earnings from 08/09 totaled almost \$7000.
