Please note: *This is a basic supply list to start the year. Some of these items will not be needed on the first week of school. Other items specific to each team or teacher will be required and that information will be sent home the first week of school. Due to budget constraints, a list of requested donations are include to support instruction.*

Sixth Grade

- 5 each 1 to 1^{1/2} inch 3 ring binder (assorted colors)
- 1 each 1^{1/2} - 2 inch 3 ring binder w/ pencil pouch (math)
- 5 sets of 5 each Subject dividers (no pockets)
- Notebook paper – wide ruled (**needed daily**)
- 1 Zipper pencil case or pouch
- Blue or black pens (no glitter gel pens) (**needed daily**)
- Red pens (for grading) - continuous supply
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 Highlighter any color (**needed daily**)
- #2 Pencils - continuous supply (**needed daily**)
- 1 package graph paper
- 1 Package hole reinforcements
- 350 – 3x5 lined index cards (*need throughout the year*)
- 1 Composition Book, cloth binding, 100 pages
- 10 plastic sheet protectors
- 1 Calculator (basic)
- 1 USB Flash/Thumb drive (~150 MB – 1 GB)

Recommended for Home Use

- Clear ruler (metric/inches) and protractor
- Dictionary

Seventh Grade

- Large (2–3 inch) three ring binder
- 1^{1/2} inch 3 ring binder(Math w/dividers)
- 15 Subject dividers (no pockets) for binder
- Notebook paper (wide ruled - continuous supply)
- 1 Zipper pencil pouch
- 1 Individual pencil sharpener
- Blue and black pens (no gel pens) - continuous supply
- Red pens (for grading) - continuous supply
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 package graph paper (¼ inch)
- 1 package hole reinforcements
- 25 plastic sheet protectors
- 3 Highlighters (three different colors)
- #2 pencils (continuous supply)
- 1 Composition Book, cloth binding, 100 pages
(if student is new to Booth)
- 1 USB Flash/Thumb drive (~150 MB – 1 GB)

Recommended for Home Use:

- World Almanac
- Collegiate Dictionary and Thesaurus
- Ruler (metric and inches) and protractor
- Scientific calculator (*with pi, square root, exponent key*)

- 1 box of Band Aids
- 2 Glue sticks
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 2 reams of bond copy paper

Eighth Grade

- 1 Large three ring binder
- Subject dividers (at least 7)
- Notebook paper – wide or college ruled
- Pencil pouch
- Black, blue, and red pens & highlighters
- #2 Pencils
- 2 1” 3 ring binders (for Reading & Math)
- 1 Composition Book, cloth binding, 100 pages (*if student is new to Booth*)
- 1 USB Flash/Thumb drive (~150 MB – 1 GB)

Donations for classroom use:

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 2 Reams of bond copy paper
- 1 box of Band-aids
- 1 box of baby wipes
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer

NOTE: 1. Backpacks with wheels generally don't fit in our lockers.

2. Locker shelves should be SQUARE. Most rectangular shelves won't fit in the lockers.

Locker interior dimensions: 10 ½” x 12”
